

## **VIRTUAL PRESENTATION ARUS 2021**

### **GUIDELINES FOR PREPARING YOUR VIDEO**

Duration: 15 minutes

File size: 100MB max

Video file format: mp4

Dimensions: Minimum height 480 pixels, aspect ratio: 16:9

Resolution: 720p or 1080p high definition

The first slide of the video presentation must contain:

- a) the title of the paper
- b) authors' name and affiliation
- d) session number

Presenter can present in front of a camera OR voice over slides OR a combination of any other creative methods for presentation.

- a) All presentation must be in English.
- b) Audio commentary and all information on the slides must be clearly presented.
- c) No background music is allowed.

Showing a speaker view is recommended but not compulsory. If you choose to do so, please make sure the speaker window does not cover slides.

There are several video conferencing tools that allow speaker view to be recorded along with slides presentation. Here are some examples:

- a) a video in mp4 format or a downloadable video link
- b) presentation slides in Microsoft PowerPoint format
